Plead the Blood!

“Father, You are *Jehovah-tsidkenu*. You are my Righteousness. I stand before You righteous and forgiven because of the Blood of Your dear Son. You are *Jehovah-m'kaddesh*, “the Lord Who Sanctifies.” You conform me into the image of Your Son and break sins’ power over me. You are *Jehovah-shalom*, my Peace. Jesus made peace by the Blood of His cross and reconciled me to You. Now Your peace which passes all understanding keeps my heart and my mind. You are *Jehovah-shammah*. You have filled me with Your overflowing presence, and You will never leave me nor forsake me. Thank You for living in me, Lord. You are *Jehovah-rophe*, the Lord Who heals every area of my life. Thank You that healing is a finished work because of the stripes that Jesus took for me. You are *Jehovah-jireh*, “Jehovah’s Provision Shall be Seen.” You made provision for my sin and need and because Jesus has taken the curse away, I am free from failure, for You have ordained my success. You are *Jehovah-nissi*, my Banner. It is Jesus that goes into battle before me, gives me the victory and makes me a conqueror. You are *Jehovah-rohi*, my Shepherd.” Thank You that you are my Shepherd, the One that feeds, leads, protects and cares for me.”

Section One

- I. Our Father which art in Heaven
 - A. Form a mental picture of the Blood shed by Jesus on the cross.
 - B. Thank God you can call Him “Father” by virtue of that Blood.
- II. Hallowed be Thy Name
 - A. Benefit 1: Sin-forgiveness of sin and deliverance from sin’s dominion
 1. Hallow His Name.
 - a. Jehovah-tsidkenu: Jehovah Our Righteousness
 - b. Jehovah-m'kaddesh: Jehovah Who Sanctifies
 2. Make your faith declarations.
 - B. Benefit 2: Spirit-fullness of the Holy Spirit
 1. Hallow His Name.
 - a. Jehovah-shalom: Jehovah Is Peace
 - b. Jehovah-shammah: Jehovah Is There
 2. Make your faith declarations
 - C. Benefit 3: Soundness-health and healing
 1. Hallow His Name.
 - a. Jehovah-rophe: Jehovah Heals
 2. Make your faith declarations.
 - D. Benefit 4: Success-freedom from the curse
 1. Hallow His Name
 - a. Jehovah-jireh: God’s Provision Shall Be Seen
 2. Make your faith declarations.
 - E. Benefit 5: Security-freedom from the fear of death and hell
 1. Hallow His Name
 - a. Jehovah-rohi: Jehovah My Shepherd.
 - b. Jehovah-nissi: Jehovah My Banner
 2. Make your faith declarations
- III. Am I taking the Lord’s Name in vain?
 - A. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal areas in which you may be taking the Lord’s Name in vain.
 - B. Submit yourself to the lordship of Christ.
- IV. Pray in the Spirit, worshipping and making melody in your heart to the Lord.

Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done
Section Two

- I. Make a declaration of faith: “Thy kingdom come, Thy will be Done - not simply willed-but done,”
Come kingdom of God! **Be done** will of God!
Boldly declare that God’s kingdom shall come and His will shall be done in these four major areas.
James 5:16b the effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.
- II. Four major areas to establish His kingdom
 - A. Yourself
 1. Be sure you are right before God.
 2. Declare righteous, peace and joy in the Holy Ghost.
 3. Ask Jesus to be seated on the throne of your life and to rule in every area. Spirit, soul and body.
 4. Abide before the Lord until the course of your day is set and the Spirit of God is functioning in you.
 - B. Your family
 1. Mate – plead the Blood. The family is only as strong as the marriage. This is a targeted area. Urgency!
Intercede, ask God to keep your loved ones in His perfect will today.
 2. Children – plead the Blood. War against hell.
Heaven won’t be Heaven without my children there.
Relationships, career, spouse, calling, purity, details.
 3. Other family members
 - C. Your church
 1. Your Pastor – anointing, marriage, pray in a Word.
 2. Leadership of church – marriages, prayer, blessings.
 3. Faithfulness of the people – church, tithes, Jesus.
 4. The harvest – souls, prodigals, north, south, east, west.
 - D. Nation
 1. City, state and national political leaders
 2. Spiritual leaders
 3. Revival
- III. Ask the Spirit of God:
 - A. To implement your priorities.
 - B. To help you live them out.

Give us this day our daily bread
Section Three

- I. Be in the will of God
 - A. Lord, help me to grow, to develop a consistent daily prayer life and spend time with You in Your Word. Desire – Discipline – Delight. Guard and pray for spiritual hunger.
 - B. Lord, help me to guard my heart against offense. I choose to be unified with my Pastor and the people of my church. in prayer I will guard against the enemies attempt to separate me from the life of the body.
 - C. Lord, help me to work diligently so that I am a good witness for You. Strengthen me with efficiency, might, balance and a spirit of excellence.
 - D. Lord, I choose to trust You, it is with joy that I will faithfully bring the tithe to Your house. Thank You that you have delivered me from all fear. I choose to be a cheerful giver Please use my tithe and offering for souls to be saved. Bless my church.
- II. Believe it is God’s will to prosper you
 - A. Memorize Scriptures such as Luke 6:38 and Phil. 4:19 to use as faith declarations as you pray in your provision. (Example) I thank You Lord that the windows of Heaven are open over my life, my family, my church because I tithe. I declare You as my source. I thank You that I am a citizen of Your kingdom. I choose to seek Your kingdom and righteousness first. You meet my every need and have blessed me to bless others.
 - B. Meditate upon the Word of God until you truly understand and believe it is God’s will to bless you.
- III. Be specific.
 - A. Bring specific needs daily before God.
 - B. Decide to pray instead of worry.
- IV. Be tenacious.
 - A. Repossess lost ground the devil has stolen from you. Discouragement and unbelief have robbed you of answers to prayer. Take up those petitions again and persevere until the answer comes.
 - B. Praise the Lord because He is Jehovah-jireh: He sees Your need beforehand and makes provision.
